4.2 Entry procedure

4.2.1 Competitors made their entry by completing the electronic entry form published on website www.sams-asn.sk/prihlaska3.php till the closing date for entry. Competitors should also send following documents on e-mail address:

autoklub@rallye.sk: - confirmation of the payment of the entry fee
- copy of valid competitor's license

Entry for shakedown and order of the additional and adjacent space in the service park (if needed) is part of the electronic entry form.

Entry will be accepted only if it is accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee.

Organiser will confirm receipt of the entry by e-mail after closing of the entries. Competitors than must print the entry form (including technical and safety equipment card), sign it and submit it to the organiser during registration for reconnaissance.

4.2.2 PZM licence holders will enter in compliance with PZM rules into PZM Inside system:

a) They must fill in the electronic entry form before the closing date for entries and send or put in the Inside PZM system all necessary current documents. The electronic entry form allows entry for manufacturers, sponsors and teams classification.

The Application also include safety equipment card of driver and co-driver to pass at the Scrutineering.

b) Before closing date for entry, the competitor is obligated to put in the Inside PZM system a color photocopy of both sides of sporting licenses (competitor, driver and co-driver licenses) and attach a confirmation of the entry fee payment. After the approval, the entry form will be automatically send by e-mail to the Organiser and to the Competitor (to the indicated in entry for e-mail address).

c) An entry application will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fee confirmation.

d) During a filling out the electronic entry form the order form of additional space (optional) and request for adjacent space in the Service Park (optional) will be available.

e) The competitor who wishes to receive a VAT invoice for the entry fee and other fees must attach to the entry form a billing details. In addition, the message accompanying the transfer must include the tax number for the invoice.

4.6 Refunds of the Entry fee

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- to candidates whose entry has not been accepted,
- in the case of the rally not taking place.
- to entries who cancelled the entry before the closing date for entries.

Organizer will refund 60% of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reason of the „force majeure“ (duly certified) are unable to start in this rally and were apologize their absence before administrative check. This must be applied for in writing containing reason for claim.

5. INSURANCES

5.1 Description of insurance cover

The insurance premium is included in the entry fee. Policy No. 6574436169 concluded by SAMŠ and Kooperativa, Vienna Insurance Group a.s., insurance company guarantees the crews' s and organiser's cover for civil liability towards third parties up to the amount of € 233 000 on the SS routes. The insurance cover will come into effect from the start of shakedown and will cease at the end of the rally or at the moment of retirement or exclusion.

5.2 Organizer does not take any responsibility for the losses and the damages in regard to the competitors' and crews' life, health and property. The crews take part in the event at their own risk.

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Competing numbers, rally plates, driver/co-driver names and organizers' advertising must be affixed on the car as shown in Appendix 4 of these Supplementary regulations from arrival to the Scrutineering.

Their placement will be controlled by officials on Scrutineering and by judges of the fact during the rally.

6.2 If it is found at any time during the rally that:

- 1 competition number or rally plate is missing, a cash penalty of € 165 will be imposed,
- more competition numbers are missing the crew will be reported to the Stewards which may impose a sanction as provided for in Art. 12.2 and 12.3 of the ISC,
- organizer's optional advertising is missing or deployment of compulsory/optional advertising, start numbers, rally plate not conform to Appendix 4 of these SR, or any change in shape or size of the organizers' advertising – every infringement will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course with cash penalty up to the entry fee of the crew.

7. TYRES

All tyres used during the rally must comply with FIA Sporting Regulations 2020 or 2012 irrespective, they were homologated before or after 01.05.2013. Hand cutting or modification of the design is possible only in the Service park.

Tyres used by competitors in RSMP /HRSMP must comply with art.14 RSMP/HRSMP 2020 Regulations.

8. FUEL

8.1 Only fuel meeting requirements of Appendix J (Art. 252.9) is possible to use.

8.2 Refuelling may be performed only in refuelling zone described in the Road Book according FIA Sporting regulations. HRSMP participants also on petrol stations described in the road book.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 Procedure for registration

During registration, each crew will receive following:

- identification sticker which must be affixed in right upper part of the windscreen during reconnaissance at all times. Any missing sticker will mean failure of the reconnaissance rules. In the sticker is damaged or in the case of the changing of the reconnaissance car, the crew need to ask for new sticker.

Reconnaissance with unmarked or other than noticed car will be penalised by Clerk of the Course with a fine 100 € for each detected case.

- GPS tracking unit.

9.2 Reconnaissance schedule

Reconnaissance must be carried out in accordance with the time schedule specified in Appendix 2 of these Supplementary regulations.

9.3 Specific and national restrictions – speed limit

9.3.1 Number of SS passages during reconnaissance is limited on 3, except:

SS Jahodná - 2 passages are allowed. SS Bankov – 1 passage is allowed.

For participants of the shakedown is allowed 1 passage (from RP2 to Stop) of SS Jahodná on Saturday 17.10.2020 and during a returning on part between RP2 and Start.

9.3.2 All crews must observe the Traffic Laws of the Slovak Republic during the reconnaissance.

9.3.3 Passage along the SS Bogota, SS Jahodná (between Start and Radio-point RP2) and SS Bankov is permitted only in direction which is prescribed in the Road Book.

9.3.4 The speed limit is given by traffic regulations of the Slovak republic during reconnaissance, except SS Bogota, SS Jahodná (between RP1 and RP2), where maximum speed 50 km/h is allowed..

9.3.5 Speeding during reconnaissance will incur a penalty applied by the Clerk of the course as follows:

- speeding up to 10%: without penalty
- speeding 10 - 40%: 5 € per 1 km/h.
- speeding 40 - 70%: 20 seconds time penalty
- speeding about 70 - 100%: 60 seconds time penalty
- speeding above 100%: 5 minutes time penalty

9.3.6 Any other violation of traffic laws will be penalized by the stewards.

9.4 Compliance with reconnaissance rules (number of passages, speed, driving in opposite direction, ...) will be controlled by judges of fact and/or GPS. Speeding will be checked by GPS.

9.5 Any breach of the reconnaissance rules specified in the Art. 9 (other than speeding) will be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to the start refusal.

9.7 All fines imposed for infringement of the reconnaissance must be paid on Rally Headquarter till 12:30 on Saturday, 17.10.2020 respectively by the time specified in the decision about penalty.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECK

10.1 Documents to be presented at the Administrative check

- competitors license, drivers and co-drivers competition license (including medical cards),
- driving licenses of driver and co-driver
- car sporting pass issued by ASN or FIA technical passport of the rally car, HRSMP cars - National Historic Technical Passport
- technical passport of the rally car
- vehicle insurance policy
- completed entry form and technical card (for Scrutineering)

Crews from abroad must show their ASN authorization to take part in the rally (except CEZ participants).

Organiser strongly recommend to use European health insurance card (E111) to all foreign crews.

10.2 Each crew should report to the Administrative check well in advance of its scheduled Scrutineering time.

11. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING OF THE MECHANICAL PARTS

11.1 Scrutineering place and schedule

11.1.1 Scrutineering will be held in service MORIS Slovakia s.r.o., Alejová 4, Košice according time schedule published on kosice.rallye.sk, on Saturday, 17.10.2020, 07:00 – 10:00 (SRP 10:00 – 11:30). Facultative Scrutineering will be held on Friday, 16.10.2020, 17:30 – 21:30, only for pre-registered crews (till 04.10.2020 - as part of the entry form, necessary for shakedown participants).

11.1.2 Any lateness to the Scrutineering will be penalized by the Clerk of the Course with cash penalty € 5 for every minute of the lateness. Any crew reporting his rally car more than 30 minutes late could not be allowed to start upon the decision of the Stewards.

11.1.3 National PZM pre-season Scrutineering will be respected.

11.2 Mud flaps: according Appendix J Article 252.7.7

11.3 Windows/Nets: according Appendix J Article 253.11

11.4 Driver's safety equipment

Competitors are compulsory to demonstrate on Scrutineering all parts of their clothes including helmets (and FHR if are prescribed) which must comply with appropriate FIA, resp. SAMŠ regulations.

11.5 Noise level

Permitted outer noise level is 96 dB(A) with tolerance +2 dB(A) for a measurement error. Exceeding will be penalized by start refusal. Exceeding measured during rally will be announced to the Stewards, which may impose a sanction as provided for in Art. 12.2 and 12.3 of the ISC.

11.6 Special national rules

Document to be presented on Scrutineering:

- Technical passport of the rally car
- Car sporting pass issued by ASN or FIA technical passport of the rally car, HRSMP cars - National Historic Technical Passport
- Completely filled technical card (checked on Administrative check) and card of the crew's safety equipment
- Homologation form
- Verifications (safety rollbar, tank catalyser ...)

11.7 On-board cameras

Mounting of cameras will be checked on scrutineering. If the camera will be mounted in car only during the rally, the crew must ask scrutineers to check it on exit from the service.

12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 Start

12.1.1 Ceremonial start

Ceremonial start will be held on Saturday 17.10.2020 at 13:00 on starting podium on parking place front of the BC Aupark, Košice.

12.1.2 SS starting system

SS starts (except SS Jahodná) will be given by an electronic clock countdown system clearly visible to the crew from the start position. The system is electronically coupled to a start line detection device (photocell) that records any start made before the signal has been given. This start line detection device is 40 cm behind the start line. The car must be placed in such a way that its front part is on the start line. The marshal gives following signals:

- 30 s - he shows on starting countdown system
- 15 s - he shows "15" on a table
- 10 s - he shows "10" on a table
- 5 s - he shows on starting countdown system, counting down by seconds together with noise signal
- start - when the last five seconds have elapsed and red light turn to green.

Further on is valid Art. 48 of FIA Sporting Regulations.

12.1.3 Start to circuit SS Jahodna

Start to SS is flying, crews will start to SS on the starter instruction. The crews had to complete the SS route as described in the road book. In the case, that crew will run more laps, the actual time will be recorded. Clerk of the Course will allocated the time in the case, that crew will run less laps.

12.1.4 Re-Start after retirement / Super rally system

a) **CEZ / CEZH** – it is not

b) **MSR / MSRHA** - Any crew which retire during Leg 1 can restart to the Leg 2 according to Art. 54 of FIA Sporting Regulations for MSR. It must announce it in written to the Organiser till 21:00, 17.10.2020 (at least sms and then in written). Scrutineers (in the presence of a competitor's representative) must check the rally

car which retired for crash before start of repairs. All restarted cars must be placed into the Parc fermé the latest on 18.10.2020 from 06:50 till 07:00 for technical controls.

c) RSMP/ HRSMP - Any crew which retire during Leg 1 can restart to the Leg 2 according to Art. 12.11 of Sporting Regulations for RSMP/HRSMP. It must announce it in written to the Organiser till 21:00, 17.10.2020 (at least sms and then in written). Scrutineers (in the presence of a competitor's representative) must check the rally car which retired for crash before start of repairs. All restarted cars must be placed into the Parc fermé the latest on 18.10.2020 from 06:50 till 07:00 for technical controls.

12.2 Finish procedure

All crews must place their vehicles in a Parc fermé after finish - TC9E (SRP 4C) – passage according road book will be checked by GPS and/or by judges of fact. All cars must be chosen from Parc fermé after publication of the official final classifications at latest at 18:00 on Sunday, 18.10.2020.

12.3 Early check-in at the end of the Leg

Early check-in is allowed for CEZ/ CEZH/ MSR/ RSMP/ MSRHA/ HRSMP/ RL/ RHP do TC 4B.and SRP to TC 2C.

12.4 Service park, promotional and advertising activities

12.4.1 Service park will opened on Friday 16.10.2020 from 10:00. Service park area will not be guarded during the night, the organizer does not take material responsibility for things left inside.

12.4.2 Refuelling is forbidden in the service park area since its opening on Friday morning. Refuelling will be possible only in the refuelling zone, the first will be on Saturday 17.10.2020 from 12:00.

12.4.3 In the service car park, a "service park zone" will be defined for each entered crew as specified in Art. 4.4.4.3.

12.4.4 In addition to the rally car other cars bearing the "Service" plate have allowed entry to the Service park as fit into the "zone" reserved for the team in the Service park. Cars marked with "Auxiliary" plate and marked as Recce cars can be placed only if they have place in "zone" reserved for the team. They may also park in designated parking area near to Service park.

12.4.5 During service it is compulsory to put under the rally car a sheet with dimensions 5 x 3 m, which is impermeable for petrol and oils. Minimum 150 l bag for waste is compulsory in each team's service.

When leaving the Service Park competitors must collect waste, put it in the container and restored the place as it was before.

12.4.6 All commercial actions are strongly forbidden in the service areas! All business activities (sale of refreshments, food, tires, spare parts, promotional items, clothing) activities may be made only with written permission and under the conditions set by the organizers.

12.4.7 Trailers can be placed only into the zone allocated for the team respectively on designated place next to the Service park according organisers instructions.

12.4.8 Any infringement of the Service park rules will be penalised by Clerk of the Course by cash penalty up to € 500.

12.5 Official time during the rally

According GPS time valid for this time zone.

12.6 Retarders (chicanes)

12.6.1 Artificial barrier on SS route formed by line of tyres is considered as retarder.

12.6.2 150 m front of a retarders will be board (exclamation mark and 150 m) placed to warn crew for incoming retarder. Passage through the retarder will be shown in the road book and will be marked by word "Retarder" in the column "Information".

12.6.3 Each incorrect passing of the retarder will be recorded by the Judge of fact. Incorrect passage through retarder means shifting of the struts of tyres (even partial) away from platform circle of retarder.

Every incorrect passage will be penalized:

- shift of 1 struts of tyres or flipping: 10 s

- shift of more than 1 struts of tyres: 30 s.

12.7 Procedure in the case of accident and accident reporting

12.7.1 All participants must be properly familiar with Art. 53 of the FIA Sporting regulations.

Organiser first aid mobile phone: +421 911 824 372.

12.7.2 If a crew is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the driver or co-driver concerned must remain at the scene and stop the following car which has to report this to the next radio point as specified in the road book and signed on the route.

Crew does not continue in Rally and waits for arrival of police

12.7.3 Crew is compulsory notify the organizer about every damage caused to third parties by its car latest 1 hour after retirement or after entry into the finish Parc fermé.

12.8 Withdrawal from the rally

Crew is compulsory report its retirement from the rally to the organizers' phone number: **+421 911 824 372** and submit the time card to the next control post (TC, STOP) or to the sweeper car or safety "99" car.

12.9 Shakedown (optional, paid)

Place: Zlatník (48°49'3''N, 21°4'58''E)

Date and time: 17.10.2020, Saturday, 07:30 – 10:30

Route: distance is 2,2 km

Entry for shakedown is a part of the entry form, the fee is € 120. Only crews who have passed the administrative checks and scrutineering may participate and only a crew's members entered on rally can be present in the rally car. Service during the shakedown will be on parking place front of the Pension Sivec. The schedule will be announced by the organizer depending on the number of entered crews.

- 15.2.2** If the protest requires the dismantling and the re-assembly of different parts of car, the claimant must pay an additional deposit according the decision of the Stewards.
- 15.3.3** Sum for a national appeal deposit is € 1340 (SRP € 670).

Appendix 5: GPS TRACKING SYSTEM

Competition and recce cars must be fitted with a safety tracking system provided by the organiser. Correct using of this system is compulsory during whole recce and also during the rally.

Before the scrutineering, the competition vehicle must be fitted with power to the GPS unit, whose correct installation will be checked during scrutineering.

a) GPS unit (installation kit): GPS unit, 12V cigarette lighter power cable for recce, SOS console with a connection cable to GPS unit and connection to power (+12V DC) during rally.

b) Fitting of the GPS unit to the recce car and using during recce

GPS unit must be connected to 12V socket and has to remain in car during the reconnaissance.

Recce cars without installed unit will not be allowed on the SS for reconnaissance. Crews can verify the GPS unit functionality on no. +421 905 600 955.

Any infringement concerning the use of the tracking system during the reconnaissance will be reported by the Clerk of the Course and will be penalized by the Stewards.

c) Installation of GPS unit into the rally car

Please ensure direct connection to power (+12V DC) before the circuit breaker

with a 5A fuse protection at column B on the side of the co-driver.

After the reconnaissance, the GPS unit has to be installed in the rally car on the B pillar. SOS panel must be connected to GPS unit with the 15 pin socket cable. This installation will be checked before the Ceremonial Start.

d) Safety Emergency Console (SOS panel) operation

SOS console must be placed in rally car so, that it is available by both competitors restrained occupant condition.

It is recommended for the floor between the two seats or the cab roof. In the case that justified the use of the SOS signal (the crews need help), turn the two-position switch to other position under a red switch cover. Then GPS unit sends SOS signal to the Rally Control. Closing of red switch cover turns off SOS signal.

e) Return of GPS kit

The competitors must dismount the complete GPS kit with all accessories and return it to Rally Headquarter as soon as possible in the case of retirement or on the end of rally or to GPS service provider at Finish Parc Fermé.



Appendix 7: RALLY LEGEND

The Rally Legend is a demonstration of historic vehicles on the SS route without measuring of the time.

Eligible crew - driver and co-driver holding a driving license and a valid driver's license issued by SAMŠ or an ASN of an EU Member State, minimum daily license.

A daily license will be obtained by a driver / co-driver on the basis of an instruction on the rally, a fee of € 5.

4.3.2.5 RL: Historical cars or their replicas, homologated until 31.12.1996, may participate. The vehicle must have a valid passport and RLTP, HTP, NHTP, or HRCP.

Vehicles homologated from 1.1.1991 to 31.12.2000 must be original competing vehicles that represent the brand and are in compliance with the original technical prescriptions. The safety equipment must comply with the minimum safety regulations for the Rally Legend.

Appendix 8: HISTORIC REGULARITY RALLY

RHP is destined for competitors and drivers from FIA CEZ countries who have valid:

- a) Competitor's and Driver's International Licenses;
- b) Competitor's and Driver's National Licenses issued by ASN from CEZ Country;
- c) SAMŠ Driver National License or RHP Restricted National License issued by SAMŠ.

RHP events can be also attended by drivers who:

- a) register for this event and receive a "daily license", subject to the conditions of the SAMŠ Yearbook, they are obliged to attend the briefing;
- (b) hold a driver's and competitor's license issued by ASN outside of the CEZ countries, they have authorization to start abroad.

Eligible cars:

- cars of the period D-J (1.1.1931 to 31.12.1990) according to Appendix K with a valid HTP or NHTP;
- serial cars with registration number, valid technical certificate, valid MOT, manufactured from 1.1.1955 to 31.12.1999;
- cars that have issued FIA HRCP or SAMŠ RLTP, NHRCP passes;
- vehicles with FIVA attestation and special registration number 'H' produced from 1.1.1955 to 31.12.1989.

Cabriolet vehicles must have a rollcage. Safety equipment according to Appendix "K" and "J" (rollcage, fire extinguisher, seat belts and seats, electric circuit breaker) is strongly recommended for all RPH regularity rally cars.

Minimum safety equipment for RHP crew

- a) Helmet - at least approved for road traffic (compulsory use on SP only)
- b) any overall,
- c) any underwear
- d) any gloves
- e) ankle boots.

Division of RHP vehicles

All eligible cars are ranked together without division into classes.

The prescribed average speed and the prescribed time to pass the SP will be published in the Bulletin for a maximum of 1 hour before the start. The winner will be the crew with the smallest sum of the deviations from the set ideal time together with the sum of all penalties and possible time penalties.
